Dear Valued Patient,

We understand that dental care can be expensive. We also know that many families do not have dental insurance or that employer-sponsored plans may not always provide for all dental care. Our unique Altima 0% Financing Program is designed to help you get the dentistry you need now, with affordable monthly payments. It's the most affordable plan in our industry!

How do I apply?

Once you and your dentist have agreed on a treatment plan, we will help you complete a confidential financing application. This form is faxed to our affiliate - Altiva CareCredit - who will verify your credit history, often the same day. All of your personal and credit information is kept strictly confidential.

What type of payment plans do you offer?

Our payment plans are flexible, and can be tailored to suit your budget. Depending on the amount of treatment you require, terms may be arranged from 6 to 24 months with corresponding monthly installments.

Do I have to pay a deposit?

Yes, an initial deposit of a minimum 10% of the total treatment plan is required.

Is there a fee?

There is a one time set-up fee based on the length of term chosen (minimum \$50) to cover the cost of processing your application, arranging the monthly payments and managing your account over time. There are no other fees or interest charges involved.

Can I pay for a portion of the treatment first, and then apply for the remainder?

Certainly. You can apply for any amount up to a maximum of your treatment plan.

Can I pay off the balance before the end of my approved term?

Absolutely. You can pay the amount financed in full (or in part to reduce your term) at any time. Your dental centre can discuss these arrangements with you.
